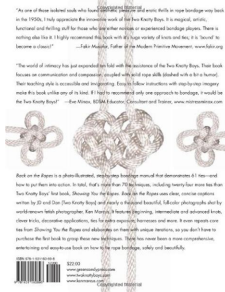

"The use of these knotted rope was first recorded in 1888 in a book by a man who had been a sailor in the 1850s. I think it's important to note that the knot is a square knot, also known as the reef knot or Whitehead knot. There is nothing else like it. It is the only knot that can be made with a single strand of rope and still be used to secure a vessel." — Alan Watts, 1958, The Way of Zen, London: Duckworth
