The 1991 NOAA Report estimates that Texas Coastal wetlands totaled 1,648,400 acres (Field et al., 1991). Coastal wetlands include salt and fresh marshes, forested scrub/shrub, and tidal flats. Of this total, 962,400 acres are classified as coastal marshes.

The lake covers 26,810 acres, has a maximum depth of 20 feet and an average depth of 8-10 feet [1, 2]. The Caddo Lake habitat, described as a wetland having both bottomland hardwoods and bald cypress swamps, supports the largest populations of certain duck species and the most diverse fish fauna in Texas [3].
